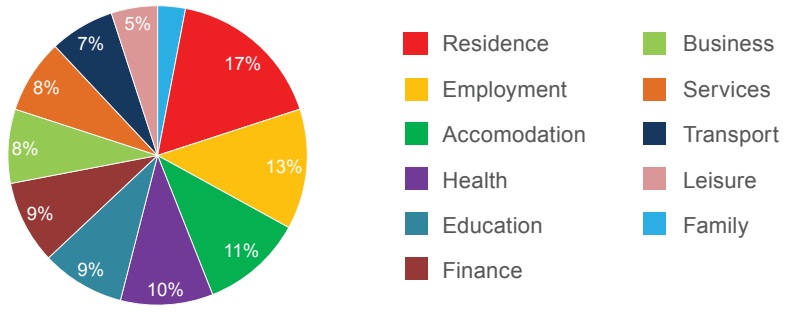

Facts and figures

- BEC has over 2,800 registered members
- every month more than 3,500 subscribers receive our newsletter
- our website records over 11,000 impressions and 8,000 visits a month. In total it has recorded 103,000 unique visitors in the last four years
- we have organized over 100 events (seminars, informal meetings, trips, sport tournaments, blood donation, ball, etc.) attended by 1,800 people
- significant numbers of expats who contact us work for major international employers in Brno and many clients also come from international research centres such as CEITEC, RECETOX, ICRC, Czech Globe, etc.
- 1,600 foreign nationals from 89 countries have contacted us with 3,300 inquiries
- most represented are foreigners from the USA, UK, Romania, Italy, India, France, Russia and Hungary
- two-thirds of the BEC members come from EU countries
- 3,300 fans follow our FB page and over 4,000 users view the posts weekly
- 8 consultants work for the BEC in specific fields of expertise

Brno builds on its industrial heritage in bid to make itself a hub for research

“Many factors make Brno attractive: it has 85,000 students at 13 universities and colleges, a rich history, good communications - including an airport - the region’s largest exhibition ground, a great quality of life and an international outlook,” says Ms Zezulkova.
